



## Camping/Overnight Rules and Regulations

1. To camp during Madison County Fair, Reserved and Non-Reserved Campers must participate as a Volunteer or Exhibitor/Family.
2. No campers (reserved or non-reserved) on fairgrounds before 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 16. Otherwise there will be a \$50 per day extra charge.
3. Reserved campers may set up at any time between Saturday, July 16 at 6:00 p.m. and Wednesday, July 20th a.m. You may go directly to your assigned camping spot. Reserved camping sticker can be obtained at the Fair Office. Full payment for reserved campers must be sent with application.
4. No Buddy Campers.
5. Non-reserved units will start moving into place on Sunday, July 17 at 2:00 p.m.
6. Pre-registration is not required for non-reserved campers. Each unit must register and pay at check-in beginning at 2:00 p.m. on the Sunday, July 17.
7. Fair board members may move in their campers starting Friday at 12 p.m. 4-H/FFA livestock superintendents (only lead superintendent) may move in their campers starting at 6 p.m. on Saturday, July 16.
8. Car parking is not allowed in area north of Varied Industries Building and in fire lanes.
9. Everyone staying on the fairgrounds must be chaperoned by a local club leader, parent, or advisor. They must stay in a place designated by the Fair Board.
10. Exhibitors cannot stay in the Livestock Barns.
11. **ALL campers need to be removed by end of day Monday, July 25**
