



Camping/Overnight Rules and Regulations

Rules and Regulations:

1. To camp during Madison County Fair, Reserved and Non-Reserved Campers must participate as a Volunteer, Exhibitor/Family or Grand Champion Level Partner.
2. No campers (reserved or non-reserved) on fairgrounds before 3:00 p.m. on Sat, July 15. Otherwise there will be a \$50 per day extra charge.
3. No Buddy Campers.
4. Reserved campers will send full payment with application. Your camping sticker, to be displayed on camper, can be obtained at the Fair Office. Campers need to be in by Wednesday a.m.
4. Non-reserved campers will register, pay and obtain your camping sticker upon entry beginning at 6:00 p.m. on the Sat, July 15.
5. Car parking is not allowed in area north of Varied Industries Building and in fire lanes
6. Everyone staying on the fairgrounds must be chaperoned by a local club leader, parent, or advisor. They must stay in a place designated by the Fair Board.
7. Exhibitors cannot stay in the Livestock Barns.
8. ALL campers need to be removed by end of day Mon, July 24th.

Camper Move-in Schedule:

Friday, July 14

- 12 p.m. Fair board campers may move into spots.
6 p.m. Grand Champion Partner campers may move into spots.

Saturday July 15:

- 3 p.m. Non-Reserved campers may start arriving to get in line. You may get in line earlier but see rule 2 above.
3 p.m. Reserved campers may start arriving and go directly to their spot.
3 p.m. 4-H/FFA Lead Livestock superintendents campers may move in.
6 p.m. Non-reserved campers will start moving into place
